Frédéric Brenner

Best known for his documentation of the Jewish diaspora since the late nineteen-seventies, the French photographer is also the organizer of "This Place," a project in which twelve noted photographers (including Josef Koudelka, Jeff Wall, and Thomas Struth) took pictures in the West Bank and Israel from 2009 to 2013. Brenner's contribution is an ambitious series titled "An Archaeology of Fear and Desire"—big color images that are as layered and complex as their wide-ranging subject. Whether portraying an Orthodox

family at the dinner table or two bearded men embracing in a garden of cacti, Brenner's photographs feel at once empathetic and evenhanded. Through July 3. (Greenberg, 41 E. 57th St. 212-334-0010.)
